The first part of the report is devoted to a general survey of the situation in the country. It is found that the economy is in a state of depression, and that the government is unable to meet its obligations. The report also points out that the population is suffering from a lack of food and clothing, and that the social conditions are deplorable.

In view of the above, it is recommended that the government should take immediate steps to improve the situation. This should include the introduction of a new currency, the abolition of the existing taxes, and the establishment of a new government. It is also recommended that the government should take steps to improve the social conditions, and to provide food and clothing for the population.
