

## ANNUAL BANQUET.

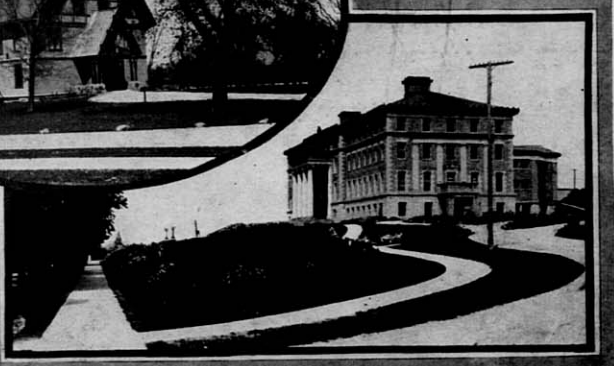
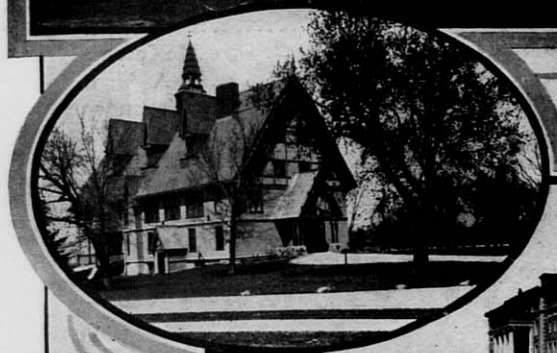
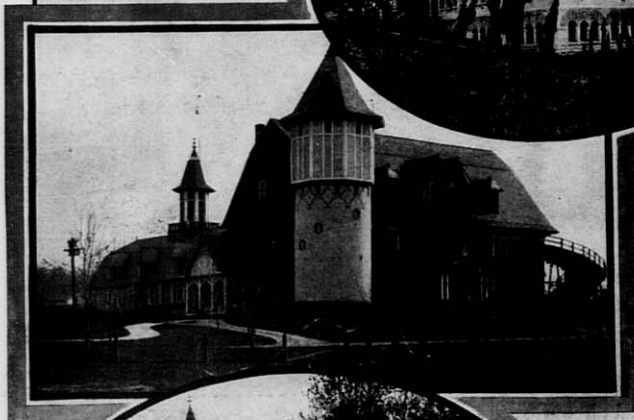
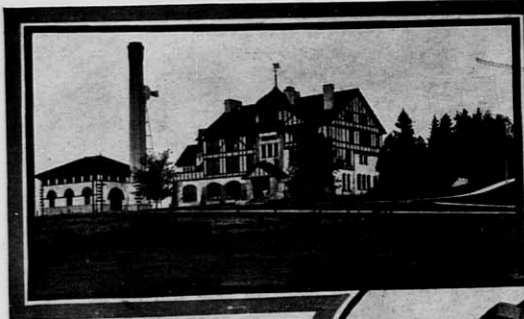
